William N Moorman of the county of Madison and
State of Wisconsin have bargained and sold and do hereby
convey unto the said William N Moorman his heirs and
assigns forever the following described premises. To wit
The South west quarter of the South East quarter of Section
thirty two (32) in Township No Seventy four (74) North
of Range No twenty eight (28) West containing forty
acres more or less And we do hereby covenant
with the said William N Moorman his heirs and
assigns to warrant and defend the said premises against
the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever
In testimony whereof the said David Ellis and Martha
E Ellis have here unto set their hands and seals this
thirteenth day of October in the year of our Lord One
thousand eight hundred and Sixty five
