One hundred ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by
Charles Conway of Madison County, and State of
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Charles Conway

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Seven Acres off the North end of the South Fifteen (15) acres
of the East half ~~is~~ of the North West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North West
Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15) in Township Seventy six (76)
North of Range Twenty Eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa.

And we hereby covenant with the said Charles Conway

that we hold said premises by good
and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said
Isabella J. Thompson hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
