rods West thence 60 rods North thence 18½ rods East thence
Sixty rods South to the place of beginning containing 5 acres
and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the
said premises against all lawful claims of all persons
whomsoever and the said Elisabeth Carlisle hereby
relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above
described premises Signed this 13th day of October 1865
