Know all Men by these Presents, That I William C. Carter

of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand 100 Dollars, in hand paid, by
John A. Walkup of Madison County, and State of
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said John A. Walkup

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
The North East quarter of the North East fractional quarter of
Section No Two (2) in Township Seventy five (75) North; of Range
No Twenty six (26) West of the 5th P. M. Iowa. — Also the North
half of the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section No
Thirty five (35) in Township No Seventy six (76) North of Range Twenty
six (26) West 5th P. M. Iowa, except Three Acres out of the North East
corner, running South from the corner Twenty four Rods, thence West
Twenty Rods, thence North Twenty four rods, thence East Twenty rods
to the place of beginning, Containing Sixty four Acres more or less.

And I hereby covenant with the said John A. Walkup
that I hold said premises by good
and perfect title, that I have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And I covenant to warrant


