Know all Men by these Presents, That We Samuel Foresman
and Rebecca Foresman of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of
Ninety ~~one~~ ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by
Frederick Cline of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said
Frederick Cline the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to wit:

South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section
No Eleven (11) Township No Seventy six (76) North, of Range
No Twenty nine West of 5th P. M. Except ten acres on the
East side of the above described premises, containing Thirty
Acres more or less.

And We hereby covenant with the said Frederick Cline that We hold said premises by good
and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And We covenant to warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said
Rebecca Foresman hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
described premises.
