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To All to whom these presents shall come I B F Roberts of Della in the county of Marion and state of Iowa Administrator of the Estate of F R Smalley late of Madison county Iowa deceased intestate send greeting Whereas the personal Estate of said deceased was found inadequate to satisfy the charges against the said estate and application having been made for license to sell so much of the real Estate as would be sufficient therefor after a full statement of all the claims against said Estate and a full account of the disposition of the personal Estate had been rendered and whereas by an order of the County Judge of said county of Madison made at the County court held at his office in Winterset in said county of Madison on the 20th day of March A D 1865 I the said Administrator was licensed and empowered to sell and convey all the interest and estate of the said F R Smalley deceased at the time of his death in and to the real Estate hereinafter described and whereas I have caused the said Real Estate to be appraised and the appraisement duly filed according to law and having given four weeks notice of the time and place of the sale of said real estate by causing a notification thereof a copy of which is hereto annexed to be printed and inserted in the newspaper called The Hawkeye Flag and published in said County of Madison for four consecutive weeks immediately preceding the day of such sale and by posting up three written notices in three public places in the said County of Madison one of which was posted on the front door of the U.S. Presbyterian church where the last district court was held and two of said notices was posted up in a public place to wit the Post office and clerks office in the Township where said Real estate is situated and one on the door leading to the county judges office and whereas I the Said Administrators having complied in all respects with the law in such cases required and with the order and direction of the said Madison County court did on the tenth day of June A D 1865 pursuant to the license and notice aforesaid sell by public auction the interest and estate of the said F R Smalley deceased at the time of his death in and to the Real estate hereinafter described to C F Mcbaughan of the

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County of Madison for the sum of Seven hundred
 Seventy six Dollars he being the highest bidder therefor
 Now therefore know ye that I the said B F Roberts as
 Administrator by virtue of the power and authority
 in me vested as aforesaid and in consideration of
 the sum of Seven hundred and Seventy six Dollars
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby
 grant bargain sell and convey unto the said C F
 McLaughan his heirs and assigns all the aforesaid
 interest and estate of the said F R Smalley deceased
 that certain tract or parcel of Real Estate situated
 in the county of Madison and state of Iowa de-
 scribed as follows to wit Lot number Six (6) in Block
 number twenty two (22) in the original town
 plat of the city of Winterset To have and to hold
 the aforesaid interest and estate of the said F R Smalley
 deceased in the above granted premises with all the
 appurtenances thereto belonging to the said C F McLaughan
 his heirs and assigns forever and I said B F Roberts
 do hereby covenant with the said C F McLaughan his
 heirs and assigns that in giving the notice and con-
 ducting said sale I have complied with all the
 requirements of the law and of the said Madison County
 court the said C F McLaughan assuming to pay
 all taxes due on said Real Estate In witness whereof
