

Know all Men by these Presents, That We J. G. Youk and Mary L. Youk husband & wife of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by Measton Glazebrook of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Measton Glazebrook the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

And We hereby covenant with the said Measton Glazebrook in that We hold said premises by good and perfect title, that We have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever.
