This Deed of Bargain and Sale, Made  
and Executed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October.  
AD 1861, by and between A. J. Stiffler and  
Mary A. Stiffler his wife, of the County

of Madison and State of Iowa, party of the first part, and Benjamin  
See party of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the  
first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars  
to them paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged, have granted and sold, and do by these presents,  
Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm, unto the said of the second  
part, his heirs and assigns, forever, the certain tract or parcel of Real  
Estate in the County of Madison State of Iowa, to wit; The One  
Undivided fourth of One acre out of the West half of the North West  
quarter of Section No<sup>r</sup> Thirty One in Township No<sup>r</sup> Seventy six North, of  
Range No<sup>r</sup> Twenty seven West, Commencing at a point Thirty rods  
due North from the North end of Jackson Street in the town of Winterset  
Madison County Iowa, parallel with the West line of said street,  
Running thence North thirteen rods, thence East twelve & one half rods,  
thence South thirteen rods, thence West twelve & one half rods to  
the place of beginning, To have and to hold the premises above

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described, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, unto him the said second party and to his heirs and assigns forever. The said A. J. Stiffler & Mary A. Stiffler hereby covenanting for themselves & heirs, Executors and Administrators, that the above described premises are free from any incumbrance; that they have full right, power and authority to sell the same, and we will warrant and defend the title to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against the claims of all persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same. And the said Mary A. Stiffler wife of the said A. J. Stiffler hereby releases and relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the foregoing described premises.
