Know all Men by these presents; That we John M. Duncan, Mary Duncan his wife, of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto Erasmus Harrell, of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit; Commencing in the Center of the East line of the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section No Twelve, Township No Seventy five (75) Range No Twenty eight (28), and running from thence South forty four (44) Rods, thence West fifty two (52) rods & twenty one (21) links thence North East down Middle River (following said River) to the center of the North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. No Twelve 12, Township No 75, Range No 28, striking said Center (27) Twenty seven Rods West of the place of beginning, thence East Twenty seven rods to the place of beginning, containing ten acres, situated in Madison County Iowa, and we do hereby covenant with the said Erasmus Harrell that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from Incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mary Duncan hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
