The South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Two, in Township Seventy seven North; of Range Twenty seven West, in the district of lands subject to sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa, containing Forty acres, according to the United States survey, and lying and being in Madison County, State of Iowa.

And we do hereby covenant with the said John K. Bell that we are lawfully seized of the said premises, that they are free from all encumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same; and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever except such (claims) as may arise from sales for taxes.
