of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and ninety Dollars, in hand paid, by Adam Stiffler of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said Adam Stiffler

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: All my right title and interest in and to the following described lands, to wit; The Undivided two ninths of the South East quarter (1/4) and of the South West quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty three (23) Township Seventy five (75) Range Twenty six (26)

And hereby covenant with the said that hold said premises by good and perfect title, that have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
