of Madison County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises,  
to-wit; The East half of the South East of Section Seven (7). Also  
West half of the South West of Section 8, Also North half of the South  
half of the North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section Seventeen (17)  
in Township 74 North of Range 28 West, Containing One hundred  
and Seventy acres more or less according to government survey.  
And we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises  
against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said  
Sarah Ann Richmond hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in  
and to the above described premises; Signed this 12<sup>th</sup> day of February
