This deed made & entered into this sixth day of March Eighteen hundred and sixty five, by and between Wyllis King & Sarah S. King his wife, of the City, County of St. Louis & State of Missouri, parties of the first part & Thomas Stevens party of the second part, Witnesseth; That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty dollars to them paid by the said party of the second part, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, conveyed & confirmed to the said party of the second part, his heirs & assigns forever, the following described Real Estate, to-wit; The North half of the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Nineteen in Township Seventy five North, of Range Twenty six West, of the Fifth Principal Meridian, situated in the County of Madison & State of Iowa, and containing Twenty acres. To have & to hold the same with all the rights privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, unto the said parties of the second part, his heirs & assigns forever, The said Parties of the first part hereby covenanting that they & their heirs, Executors, and Administrators will warrant and defend the title to the said premises, & every part thereof, to the said party of the second part, his heirs & assigns against the lawful claims of all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming or to claim title to the same or any part thereof.
