 and M. A. Gurnsey of Madison County State of Iowa
 party of the second part Witnesseth that the said party
 of the first part for and in consideration of three
 hundred and seventy five dollars in hand paid
 by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged and the said party of the second
 part forever released and discharged therefrom Released
 Released Sold Conveyed and Quit Claimed and by these
 presents do remise Release sell convey and Quit Claim unto
 unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 forever all the right title interest claim and demand
 which the said party of the first part have in and
 to the following described lot piece or parcel of land to wit
 the South half of the North East quarter of Section No Twenty
 eight (28) in Township No Seventy five (75) North Range Twenty
 six (26) West of the 5th Principal Meridian and being sit-
 uated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa
 To Have and to Hold the Same Together with all and
 singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto be-
 longing or in any wise thereto appertaining and all the
 estate right title and interest and claim whatsoever of
 the said party of the first part either in law or equity
 to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the said
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever
 And the said Lewis Leslie & Angeline Leslie party of the
 first part hereby expressly waive release and relinquish unto
 the said party of the second part his heirs executors ad-
 ministrators and assigns all right title interest and bene-
 fit whatever in and to the above described premises
 and each and every part thereof which is given by or results
 from all laws of this State pertaining to the exemption of
 Homesteads. And the said party of the first part further
 and their heirs executors and administrators do covenant
 promise and agree to and with the said party of the second
 part his heirs executors administrators and assigns that they
 have not done committed executive or sufficient any act or acts

thing or things whatsoever whereby or by means whereof the above mentioned and described premises or any part or parcel thereof now are or at any time hereafter shall so may be impeached charged or incumbered in any way or manner whatsoever
