 County State of Illinois do hereby sell and convey unto  
 the said Thomas Lewis his heirs and assigns the following  
 described premises situated in the County of Madison  
 in the State of Iowa to wit the North East fractional  
 quarter of the North East quarter of section No (6) six  
 all in Township No (7) Seventy six North of Range No (6)  
 Twenty six West containing forty acres of land more or less  
 And we do hereby covenant with the said Thomas Lewis  
 and his heirs that we lawfully seized of said premises  
 that they are free from encumbrance that we have  
 good right and lawful authority to sell the same  
 and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the  
 said premises against the lawful claims of all persons  
 whomsoever & titles of the parties excepted and the said  
 Sarah A Rensburgh hereby relinquishes her right of dower  
 in and to said premises
