Darnell the following described premises situate in the County of Madison and State of Iowa to wit the South half (1/2) of the North East quarter 1/4 of Section No fifteen and the West half 1/2 of the North East quarter 1/4 of the North East quarter 1/4 of Section No twenty three (23) all in Township number seventy five (75) North of Range number twenty seven (27) West of the 5th P.M.

And we hereby covenant with the said Gideon H. Darnell that we hold said premises by good and perfect title that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever and we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever and the said Eunice Rogers hereby relinquishes her right of Dower in and to the above described premises Signed this 24th day of February A.D. 1866
