 and State of Iowa, we do hereby sell and convey unto the said Thomas
 J. Osborn and to his heirs and assigns, the following described premises
 to-wit; The South East quarter of Section No One in Township Seventy
 five North of Range No 29 West, containing 160 Acres more or less,
 lying & being in the County of Madison & State of Iowa, and we do
 hereby covenant with the said Thomas J. Osborn that we are lawfully
 seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from encum-
 brance; that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same;
 and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises,
 and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all
 persons whomsoever; and the said Abigail Bond hereby relinquishes all her
 right of dower in and to the above described premises, Signed 14th day of June AD 1866
