This Indenture made this 30th day of August
in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight
hundred and sixty five, between Samuel S. Brooks of the County
of Adair & State of Iowa of the first part, and Charles A. Brooks
of the County of Knox and State of Illinois of the second part,
Witnesseth; That the said party of the first part, for and in con-
sideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars in hand paid, by the
said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
have Granted, Bargained and Sold and by these presents do grant, bargain
and sell unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,
all the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, situated in the
County of Madison and State of Iowa, to wit; The North West fourth
of the South East fourth of Section Twenty two Township Seventy four
Range Twenty six, Forty Acres more or less, Together with all and singular
the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise
appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remain-
ders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and all the estate, right, title, interest,
claim and demand whatsoever; of the said party of the first part, either in
law or equity, of, in and to the above bargained premises; with the heredita-
ments and appurtenances; To have and to hold the above bargained
and described, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second
part, his heirs and forever. And the said Samuel S. Brooks party of the first
part, hereby expressly waive, release and relinquish unto the said party of
the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, all right,
title, claim, interest and benefit whatever, in and to the above described
premises, and each and every part thereof, which is given by or results
from all laws of this State pertaining to the exemption of homesteads,

And the said party of the first part, for his heirs executors and administrators do covenant, grant, bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the sealing and delivery of these presents he is well seized of the premises above conveyed, as a good, sure, perfect, absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in law, in fee simple, and have good right, full power and lawful authority to grant, bargain, sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid; and that the same are free and clear from all former grants, bargains, sales, liens, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances, of what kind or nature soever; and the above bargained premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, the said party of the first part shall and will warrant and forever defend.
