the Grantee, do give, grant, Bargain, sell and convey unto the said
Grantee his heirs and assigns, the following described premises, sit-
uated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa: To-wit; The
West half of the North East quarter of Section Three (3) in Township
Seventy six (76) North; of Range Twenty nine (29) West, To have and
to hold, The above granted and bargained premises, with the appurte-
nances thereto, belonging unto said Grantee, his heirs and assigns forever.
And Asaph Shadley does for himself and heirs, covenant with the
said Grantee, his heirs and assigns, that at and until the enrolling of
these presents, that he was well seized of the premises as a good and in-
defeasible estate in Fee Simple, and has good right to bargain and
sell the same, in manner and form as above written, and that the
same are free from all encumbrances whatsoever; and will Warrant
and defend said premises, with the appurtenances, to the said Grantee,
his heirs and assigns forever against all lawful claims and demands
of all persons whomsoever. In witness whereof, I have hereunto

year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty six.
