Know all men by these presents, that we Alby Terry and Sarah Ann Terry of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Thirty Dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey, unto Samuel Cunningham of Madison County, and State of Iowa, Lot number Three in Block number Two in Bowlsbys Addition to the Original Town plat of Winterset Iowa, and we do hereby covenant with the said Samuel Cunningham that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises, and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Sarah Ann Terry hereby relinquishes her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
