of Section No Twenty four (24) in Township No Seventy six (76) North  
of Range No Twenty six (26) West of 5<sup>th</sup> P. M. and we hereby cov-  
enant with the said Conrad Weil that we hold said premises by  
title in fee simple; that we have good right and lawful authority  
to sell and convey the same; that they are free and clear of all liens  
and incumbrances whatsoever, and we covenant to warrant and  
defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons  
whomsoever; and the said Margaret Randolph does hereby re-  
linquish her right of dower in and to the above described prem-  
ises, signed this 10<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1866
