Snyder of the County of Stephenson and State of Illinois of the first part, and Andrew Ayres of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, of the second part, Witnesseth; that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the said party of the second part forever released and discharged therefrom, has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents does remise, release, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever all the right title, interest and estate that the said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; The South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section No Twelve (12) Town. Seventy six (76) Range No Twenty seven (27). To have and to hold, all the estate, right, title, ~~and~~ interest and claim whatever, in and to said premises, of the said party of the first part either in law or Equity; to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
