hundred dollars, in hand paid by R. A. Stitt of Madison County and State of
Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said R. A. Stitt the following described
premises, situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit; The
West one half (½) of the North East quarter (¼) of Section N^o Twenty eight (28) Township
N^o Seventy six (76) North of Range N^o Twenty nine (29) West, containing Eighty
Acres more or less. And we hereby covenant with the said R. A. Stitt that we hold
said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good right and lawful
authority to sell and convey the same, that they are free and clear of all liens and
incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said
premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. And the said
S. M. Baker hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises,
