 and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that

 and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said
 Susan Henson hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
 described premises.

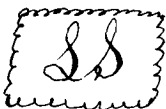
