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**Know all Men by these Presents, That we Burrel T. Woolsey & Missouri Woolsey his wife of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of One thousand Five hundred <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by Daniel H. Eyerly of Jasper County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said Daniel H. Eyerly**

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

South West of S. E. <sup>SE 1/4</sup> of SW <sup>1/4</sup> of Sec. No Seven (7) and Five Acres more or less commencing forty (40) rods East of the S. W. corner of the N.E. <sup>1/4</sup> of the N.E. <sup>1/4</sup> of Sec.
