**Know all Men by these Presents,** That we C. P. Lee & Willa Lee  
 his wife  
 of Madison County and State of Iowa

in consideration of the sum of  
 100 Dollars, in hand paid, by  
 John Bishop of Madison County, and State of  
 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said John Bishop

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Five Acres of Land off of the West side of a piece of land belonging  
 to us, commencing One hundred and forty nine &  $\frac{3}{4}$  rods West  
 of the North East corner of the South East quarter of Section (34) Township

Seventy six (76) North of Range Twenty seven (27) running thence South to the  
 middle of Middle River Eighty Rods, thence down said River a sufficient  
 distance to include Five Acres, with a line parallel with the first described  
 line.

And we hereby covenant with the said John Bishop  
 that we hold said premises by good  
 and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that  
 they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant  
 and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said  
 Willa Lee hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above  
 described premises.
