 Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Edward Noonan

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
 the East three quarters of the South West quarter of the South
 West quarter of Section No ten in Township Number Seventy six
 (76) North of Range Number Twenty Six (26) west in the
 County of Madison and State of Iowa containing (30) thirty
 Acres land Ten acres of the North West side of the South East
