the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twelve, Township Seventy six, Range Twenty seven.

NE ¼ SE ¼ 12 - 76 - 27

And I hereby covenant with the said Robert Neal that I hold said premises by good and perfect title, that I have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And I covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Susanna Ayres hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
