Know all Men by these Presents, That we Hogan Queen and Martha A. Queen husband and wife ~~inhabitants~~ of Madison County and State of Iowa ~~inhabitants~~ in consideration of the sum of One hundred ~~summons~~ ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by Jackson Conard ~~inhabitants~~ of Madison County, and State of Iowa ~~inhabitants~~ do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Jackson Conard

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Eleven Acres in the South East corner of the South half of the North East quarter of Section Eighteen Township Seventy five Range Twenty Six. Bounded as follows. Beginning at the South East corner of said tract of land, thence North forty four Rods, thence West forty Rods, thence South forty four Rods, thence East forty Rods to the place of beginning.

And we hereby covenant with the said Jackson Conard ~~inhabitants~~ that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Martha A. Queen ~~inhabitants~~ hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
