**Know all Men by these Presents,** That we Hogan Queen & Martha A. Queen husband and wife, of Madison County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Two thousand and Twenty five <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by Joseph Betts of Madison County, and State of Iowa, do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Joseph Betts,

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: The North half of the North East quarter except one half Acre in the North West corner being Twenty rods East & West and four Rods North and South, & Fifty five Acres off the North side of the South half North East Quarter to run far enough South so as to include 55 acres, excepting a tract in the South East corner of said Sixty four rods containing 11 Acres, being 44 Rods North & South & 40 Rods East & West, said land all being in Section Eighteen Township 75 Range 26.

And we hereby covenant with the said Joseph Betts that we hold said premises by good and perfect title; that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same; that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Martha A. Queen hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
