**Know all Men by these Presents,** That we James Ethertron and Rachael Ethertron, of Madison County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred & Fifty <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by James Porter of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said James Porter the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: The North East fractional quarter of the North East quarter and thirty two (32) acre off of the North End of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section two (2) also stripe ten rods wide off of the East part of the West half of the North East quarter of Section Number fifteen (15) acre in Township Seventy four (74) Range number twenty seven (27) West. And we hereby covenant with the said James Porter that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Rachael Ethertron hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
