North half (½) of the South East fourth (¼) of the North West quarter Section of Section No Sixteen (16) Township Seventy five (75) North of Range Twenty six (26) West, in the West half (½) of the above described Twenty (20) Acres, containing Ten (10) Acres more or less. ~~residents~~
