H. Weeks of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said W. H. Weeks

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: Beginning at a Stake Sixty six and two third Rods North of the South East corner of Section Thirty two (32) Township (74) Range (29) thence North Thirty two & two thirds Rods, thence West Eighty Rods, thence South Twenty Rods, thence West forty Rods, thence South Twelve & two thirds Rods, thence East One hundred & twenty Rods to the place of beginning, containing Twenty Acres more or less

And we hereby covenant with the said W. H. Weeks that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Cynthia Denney hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
