Know all Men by these Presents, That J. W. Price

of Madison County and State of Iowa
Six hundred Sixty six & ¹⁰⁰ ~~4~~ Dollars, in hand paid, by
Alexander Athison of Madison County, and State of

Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said

Alexander Athison the undivided one third part of
the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The West half of the South East quarter of section four (4) and the West half of the North West quarter of the South West quarter and the West half of the South West quarter of the North West quarter of section number ten (10) all in Township Seventy five (75) North of Range Twenty eight (28) West of 5th P.M.

And I hereby covenant with the said Alexander Athison

that I hold said premises by good and perfect title, that I have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And I covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said J. W. Price hereby relinquishes his right of dower in and to the above described premises.
