Know all Men by these Presents, That we Oliver Crawford and
Lucinda Crawford
 of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of
One Hundred ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by
William Farrell of Madison County, and State of
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said
William Farrell

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
The North half of the South West fourth of the South
West fourth of Section (28) in Township Seventy six (76) in
Range Twenty six (26) containing 20 acres more or less

And we hereby covenant with the said William Farrell
 that we hold said premises by good
 and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
 they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant
 and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said
Lucinda Crawford hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
 described premises.
