of section four (4) Township Seventy Seven (77) Range twenty (27)
containing fifteen acres and we do hereby covenant with
the said George Fisher that we are lawfully seized in fee
simple of said premises that they are free from incumbrance
that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the
same and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend
the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging
against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever
and the said Sarah Fisher wife of the said George Fisher
hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the
above described premises
