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Know all Men by these Presents, That we H. S. Short & Jane Short his wife of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of \$1000.00 One Thousand Dollars, in hand paid, by Nicholas Murray of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Nicholas Murray

the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Fifteen (15) acres off of the West End of the South half (1/2) of the North half (1/2) of the West half (1/4) of the South West quarter (1/4) of Section No. Twenty (20) Township No. Twenty six (26) and Range No. Twenty seven (27) West of 5th P.M. Iowa also a part of a certain four acre lot in a square form in the South East East corner of the West (1/4) half of the South East quarter (1/4) of Section No. Thirty six (36) Township No. Twenty six (26) North of Range No. Twenty Eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. and described as follows to wit commencing at South West corner of the said four (4) acre lot and running North (12) twelve rods thence East Eight (8) rods thence South Twelve (12) rods thence West Eight (8) rods to the place of beginning containing Ninety Six (96) square rods
