Bird of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said L. C. Bird the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: The North East quarter of the South West quarter of sec thirty four Town 76 North of Range 27

And we hereby covenant with the said L. C. Bird

that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Sarah Bird hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
