Know all Men by these Presents, That we Alexander Bonham
 and Susan Bonham his wife
 of Madison County and State of Iowa
Four Hundred in consideration of the sum of
B. B. Bonham 100 Dollars, in hand paid, by
of Madison County, and State of
do hereby Sell and Convey, unto the said
B. B. Bonham
 the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
 The North half of the North East quarter and the North half of the
 South West fourth of the North East quarter of Section number ten
 (10) in Township Seventy four (74) North of Range twenty nine (29) West
 containing one hundred acres more or less

And we hereby covenant with the said B. B. Bonham
 that we hold said premises by good
 and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
 they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant
 and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said
Susan Bonham hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
 described premises.
