Know all Men by these Presents, That we J.W. Gravas and
Mercy Gravas
of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of
Four ¹⁰⁰ Dollars, in hand paid, by
John Reed of Madison County, and State of
Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said
John Reed
the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
The South West quarter of the North East quarter and
the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty
three (23) Township Seventy five (75) Range Twenty eight (28)

And we hereby covenant with the said John Reed that we hold said premises by good
and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that
they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said
Mercy Gravas hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
described premises.
