**Know all Men by these Presents, That** David Miller and Mary Ann Miller of Madison County and State of Iowa <sup>in consideration of the sum of</sup> Four Hundred <sup>100</sup> Dollars, in hand paid, by Z. G. Peter of Madison County, and State of Iowa do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Z. G. Peter the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit: Lot number one (1) in Block number Seven (7) Original Plat of the City of West Des Moines

And we hereby covenant with the said Z. G. Peter that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mary Ann Miller hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
