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This indenture made this
seventh 7th day of September
in the year of our Lord One thousand
eight hundred and Sixty four between John Walton
and Mary Walton of the county of Peoria and state
of Illinois of the first part and John B Berry of the
county of Peoria and state of Illinois Witnesseth
that the said party of the first part for and in consideration
of the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty five Dollars in hand
paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and
by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said
party of the second part his heirs and assigns all the following
described lots pieces or parcels of land situated in the
state of Iowa in the County of Madison to wit The
South East Quarter of the south west Quarter of section
Number thirty three (33) in Township Number seventy five (75)
North of Range Twenty eight (28) West And the North East
Quarter of the North West Quarter of section Number
Four (4) Township Number seventy four (74) North of
Range Twenty eight (28) West and a piece of land off
of the North East Quarter of section Four (4) townit com-
mencing at the North West corner of said Quarter
section thence running East Ten (10) rods thence South one
hundred and sixty five (165) rods and East Twenty one
(21) degrees and Twenty minutes (20) to the South line of
said quarter section thence west to the South West
corner of said Quarter section thence North to the place
of beginning containing about Thirty acres more or
less together with all and singular the hereditaments
and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise
appertaining and the reversion and reversions remain-
der and remainders rents issues and profits thereof
and all the estate right title interest claim and
demand whatsoever of the said party of the first

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part either in law or equity of in and to the above bargained premise
 with the ~~hereditaments~~ and appurtenances to have and
 to hold the said premises above bargained and described
 with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns forever and the said John
 and Mary Walton party of the first part hereby expressly waive
 release and relinquish unto said party of second part his heirs
 executors administrators and assigns all right title claim
 interest and benefit whatever in and to the above described premises
 and each and every part thereof which is given by or results from
 all laws of this state pertaining to the exemption of homesteads and the said
 John Walton and Mary Walton party of the first part for their heirs executors and administrators
 do covenant grant bargain and agree to and with the said party of the second part
 his heirs and assigns that at the time of the sealing and delivery of these presents they were
 well seized of the premises above conveyed as a good sure perfect absolute and in de-
 pearable estate of inheritance in law in fee simple and have good right full power and
 lawful authority to grant bargain sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid
 and that the same are free and clear of all former and other grants bargains sales liens
 taxes assessments and incumbrances of what kind or nature soever and the above
 bargained premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part
 his heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons lawfully claiming unto
 claim the whole or any part thereof the said party of the first part shall and will
 warrant and forever defend In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands

 not wish to retract the same given under my hand and seal this seventh day of September A.D. 1864.
