Know all men by these presents, That I Jesse Truitt and Mary Truitt of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars in hand paid by Robert Shields of said County and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the said Robert Shields and to his heirs and assigns the following described premises, to wit: Lot No three and block No twenty eight, in the original Town Plat of Winterset, Madison Co Iowa, and we do hereby covenant with the said Robert Shields that we are lawfully seized, in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appertinances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Mary Truitt hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and to the above described premises.
