Ruttledge husband of said Nancy of Madison County and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Five hundred & fifty Dollars, in hand paid, by Stephen Lloyd of Clark County, and State of Illinois do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said Stephen Lloyd the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:
The North third of Lot No Three (3) in Block No Seventeen in the Original Town Plat of the City of Winterset

And we hereby covenant with the said Stephen Lloyd that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said G. M. Ruttledge hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
