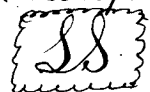

#515 Winston D. Rogers

Certificate N^o 16668. The United States of America;
To all to whom these presents shall come greeting;
Whereas Winston D. Rogers of Greene County
Pennsylvania, has deposited in the general land
Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at
Fort Des Moines whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the
said Winston D. Rogers according to the provisions of an Act of Congress of
the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale
of the public lands" for the North West fractional quarter of the North
East quarter, the South West quarter of the North West quarter, and the
North fractional half of the North West quarter of Section One, in Township
Seventy six North of Range Twenty nine West, in the district of lands subject
to sale at Fort Des Moines Iowa, containing One hundred and fifty nine acres and
Seventy six hundredths of an Acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey
of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General,
which said tract has been purchased by the said Winston D. Rogers.

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the prem-
ises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and
provided, Have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto
the said Winston D. Rogers and to his heirs, the said tract above described, To have
and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges ~~and~~ immunities and
appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Winston D.
Rogers and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof, I Franklin Pierce
President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made
patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the fifteenth day of October
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five, and of the
Independence of the United States the Eightieth
