Know all men by these presents, That we Wesley Cox and Hulda Cox of Madison County, State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of Three

hundred and twenty five Dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey, unto Jesse Wilson of Madison County and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit; The East half of the North West fractional quarter of Section No Six "6" in Township No Seventy seven 77" North of Range No Twenty eight "28" West of the 5th P.M. Iowa.

And we do hereby covenant with the said Jesse Wilson that we are lawfully seized in fee simple, of said premises, that they are free from Incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Hulda Cox hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
