Know all Men by these presents, That whereas the following described Real property, viz; Blocks No Twenty two (22) & Twenty three (23) in West Addition to the City of Winterset, situated in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, was subject to taxation for the year A.D 1860; and whereas the taxes, assessed upon said Real property, for the year aforesaid remained due and unpaid at the date of the sale hereinafter named; and whereas, the Treasurer of the said County did, on the 1st day of December 1862, by virtue of the authority in him vested by law, at the tax sale begun and publicly held on the first Monday of December A.D 1862, expose to public sale at the Treasurers Office in the County aforesaid in substantial conformity with all the requisitions of the Statute in such case made and provided, the Real property above described, for the payment of the taxes, interest and costs then due and remaining unpaid, on said property; and whereas, at the time and place aforesaid, Leonard & Mott of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, having offered to pay the sum of Two Dollars & Eighty six cents being the whole amount of taxes, interest and costs then due and remaining unpaid on said property, for all of Block No Twenty two & twenty three (23) West addition to Winterset which was the least quantity bid for; and payment of said sum having been by him made to the said Treasurer, the said property was stricken off to him at that price, and whereas Leonard & Mott have assigned their Certificate of purchase to C. A. Gaskell and whereas three years has elapsed since the date of said sale and the said property has not been redeemed therefrom as provided for by law: Now, Therefore, I, R. A. Stitt Treasurer of the County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum to the Treasurer paid as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said C. A. Gaskell his heirs and assigns, the real property last hereinbefore described, to have and to hold unto him the said C. A. Gaskell his heirs and assigns forever; subject however, to all rights of redemption provided by law. In witness whereof I R. A.
