William W. Shoenaker the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section thirty two (32) Township Twenty four (24) Range Twenty nine (29) West containing forty acres more or less

And we hereby covenant with the said William W. Shoenaker that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Eliza Ann Shoenaker hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
