Know all Men by these Presents, That we William Abernathy and Ellen Abernathy of Madison County and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Eighty Dollars, in hand paid, by John Cornelison of Madison County, and State of Iowa, do hereby **Sell and Convey**, unto the said

John Cornelison the following described premises, situate in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section Thirty Six (36) Township Seventy four (74) North of Range Twenty Eight (28) West of 5th. P. M.

And we hereby covenant with the said John Cornelison

that we hold said premises by good and perfect title, that we have good, right, and lawful authority, to sell and convey the same: that they are free, and clear of all liens and incumbrances whatsoever. And we covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the said Ellen Abernathy hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
