 No. Thirty three, in Township No. 27, N. thence W. 20 rods, thence
 S. 40 rods, thence E. 20 rods, thence N. to place of beginning.

And the said E. Compton, wife of the said A. Compton
 hereby relinquishes all right, interest or claim of dower in
 and to said land, and the said Grantors hereby covenant
 warrant and defend the title to the said premises
 against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
